

Ring Sizing Guide

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Start by printing this page. Set page scaling to "100" in your print settings and use 8.5 x 11-inch standard paper. Once it's printed, you can check the accuracy of your print by positioning a credit card in the frame below. If the card lines up, you're all set. If the credit card does not align with the frame, adjust your printer settings and print again. Some printers have an "Advanced" settings option where you can manually set the scaling to 100%.



MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

Choose a ring that correctly fits her left ring finger (next to the pinky).

Lay the ring over each size circle on the chart until the inside edge of the ring closely matches one of the circles. When your ring is correctly placed, you should only see the yellow circle with no white space inside the ring. This is your ring size! If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.
